
### Christmas Craft Instructions Jigsaw Snowflakes

#### You will need...



Old pieces of jigsaw from incomplete sets (24 piece or smaller)

PVA glue











# What you do...

Choose 6 pieces of jigsaw for the snowflake.

Using one jigsaw piece as the centre, glue each of the other pieces onto the edge of it to create a flower shape. Let it dry slightly so that it's stable.






Once dry, drizzle with glue on the grey side of the jigsaw pieces.

Sprinkle with different coloured glitter and then leave to dry.





Then turn over the snowflake and spread glue all over to cover the pattern. Sprinkle with glitter and leave to dry.

Once both sides are dry, tie a short piece of cotton around part of one of the jigsaw pieces. Then make a loop and tie at the top so it can hang on a tree.
