



Eagles Curriculum Information Summer Term 2025

Welcome back to the last term of the year but also the last ever term at Frieth for the year 6 children! We have got a very busy term coming up, so lots of hard work ahead but also some very exciting and rewarding opportunities for the children. This term, the year 6 children will complete the SATs assessments in the w.c. 12th May – further details of these tests will be communicated with you shortly. The latter half of the summer term includes our Sports' week and Summer Queen celebrations and for the year 6 children, our residential trip to Devon, transition days and Bikeability.

Please may I take this opportunity to remind you that the children need their PE kits in school on Wednesdays and Thursdays and that their homework is due every Monday and that spellings take place on Fridays with Mr Gosling. The expectation is also that they read at home every night and bring their signed reading record and a reading book into school each day.

English

The first half of the summer term will focus on the theme of Kings and Queens which links directly with our history lessons. Within English, the children will be using this topic to explore biographies, letters and diaries. For the year 6 children, there will also be a significant focus on teaching spelling, punctuation and grammar and reading skills and techniques in preparation for the SATs tests; these will be taught through the use of our topic and supplemented with revision guides and text books.

Maths

We continue to work through the year 5 and 6 curriculum for maths, with a focus on consolidating arithmetic strategies for the four operations, fractions, decimals and percentages. This term we will also be tackling algebra, ratio and statistics and continue to use a range of resources to do this, including White Rose Maths and Classroom Secrets. These resources are excellent in developing the fluency, reasoning and problem-solving skills necessary to be proficient in the Year 5 and 6 maths curriculum.

Science

Over the course of this term, our first topic is Changing Materials where the children will be exploring how materials change state under certain conditions and how changes are reversible or irreversible. Our second topic is Animals and Humans so the children will be exploring the life cycle of humans, puberty and gestational periods of animals.

R.E.

This term in RE the children will be exploring two key questions: *Are you inspired?* and *What's best for our world? Does religion help people decide?* These topics will give the children the opportunity to explore and compare different religions such as Sikhism, Islam, Christianity, Hinduism and Buddhism.

History

During history this half term, the children will be exploring the significant Kings and Queens of Britain over the years. They will investigate their family trees and backgrounds and how their reigns shaped our world today.

Geography

The children will be exploring the topic, 'Enough for Everyone!' including the needs of settlements. This includes investigating power sources, renewable vs non-renewable sources, food, water and sharing of natural resources.

Computing

The children will be working in pairs to create a stop-motion animated short. The National Curriculum target is to select, use and combine a variety of software (including internet services) on a range of digital devices to design and create content that accomplishes given goals.

French

Over the next two terms, we will be looking at the topic Les Habitats. By the end of this unit pupils will have the knowledge and skills to present both orally and in written form about various plants and animals that live in five very different habitats. Pupils will also learn the language necessary so they can detail the specific adaptations of each animal so it can thrive in its habitat.

Music

We will be learning how to write our own songs. We will write our own lyrics, and learn to play chords on various instruments, in order to have a 'Battle of the bands' at the end of the unit.

P.E.

During the summer term Eagles will be doing Athletics In their PE lessons. I will be looking for them to eagerly participate in every PE/Sport lesson displaying excellent sporting attitudes and effectively communicate and collaborate with each other. During the term they will be refining the technique of three different topics: running, throwing and jumping. They will be focusing on taking leadership roles by taking charge and demonstrating respect, encouragement and effective communication skills in their own team and model etiquette such as hand shaking and congratulations to opposition.

P.S.H.E.

This terms topic is 'Health and wellbeing' where the children will be looking at; healthy sleep habits; sun safety; medicines, vaccinations, immunisations, and allergies. They will also explore personal identity, recognising individual qualities and different qualities, mental welling, keeping safe in different situations including responding in emergencies. There will also be a unit for the year 5 and 6 children on puberty which we will communicate more information about to you in due course. We will also be doing transition work with the year 6 children in preparation to their move to secondary school.

Forest School

Eagles will spend the second half of the Summer Term at Forest School, continuing to build their knowledge and understanding of the natural world, along with their practical outdoor skills. We will encourage them to act as leaders and mentors to younger year groups within the woodland environment, as well as allowing them to stretch their own independence and creative thinking.
