Composition	To write sentences in order to create short narratives and non-fiction texts. To use some features of different text types (although these may not be consistent). To reread their writing to check that it makes sense and make suggested changes.

Transcription	To spell most words containing previously taught phonemes and GPCs (Grapheme Phoneme Correspondence) accurately.

	To add suffixes -ing, -ed, -er and -est to root words (with no change	
	to the root word).
