

Remote Learning Policy and Guidance

This policy provides a general guide to our approach to remote learning provision. Various scenarios for potential remote learning are outlined below. Please note that:

- If the whole class is learning remotely, your child will receive two daily video lessons. These will take place following the timetable in Annex A.
- Learning activities will only be provided if children are well and healthy enough to learn effectively.
- Children with SEND will receive additional video calls.
