Arrival and Collection from School

The beginning of the new academic year is a good time to remind all parents of the safety rules we currently have in place.

- Please abide by our school opening times and drop your children off between **8:45 and 8:55**. A member of staff will be on the front gate to greet the arrivals and keep an eye on the turning circle in the morning and Mrs Ansell will be on duty to look after the pupils on the back playground until the whistle blows at 8:55. Initially reception age pupils may go straight to Owls class with their parents for the 10 minute settling in period until they are happy to be left in the playground.
- **Please do not get out of your car in the drop off zone.** If you need to pop into the office, or your child is unable to let themselves out of the car, please park further away and walk in with your child.
- Please do not park in the car park after 3pm

Please only park in designated parking spaces, as parking in the entrance way to the village hall and the car park limits the space, blocks the emergency access to the school and is hazardous for the pupils walking past.

There is detailed information about pick up and drop off on the school information pages on the website. We ask all parents to read the information.

If your child requires a booster seat please ensure they bring them to school with them on Wednesday.

Travel Plan

If you have any high visibility jackets at home that your children have grown out of (perhaps they were given one at school and have now left and gone to secondary school) we would be very grateful if you would be happy to donate them to school. Please send any in to school via your child's bookbag for the attention of Mrs Sparks.



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Snacks and Drinks

We have noticed crisps and chocolate being sent in for morning snack. We are a healthy school so can we please request that only healthy snacks are sent in with your children.

We have also noticed that some parents are including Hummus in lunchboxes. This contains sesame and therefore is not allowed in school owing to severe allergies. Please do not send anything with nuts or seed bases to the product into school. If you are not sure, please check with the office.

Headlice in School
